


Sam is Year 10. His attendance rate is always around 90%. He thinks this is pretty good!

Research suggests that 17 days missed from school equates to a GCSE grade.



Preparation for exams / assessment

- Know when assessments and examinations will take place
- Help plan a revision timetable no more than 2 subjects per night
- Work out time limits for revision and social time
- Ensure there is a suitable place to study
- Offer help as a tester, reader
- Organise rewards for hard work
