Assessment in year 10

Assessments take place in each subject towards the end of each half term.

These assessments will enable teachers to make accurate judgements and provide useful feedback to help the pupils make progress.

Assessments may take different forms but in most cases will be based around GCSE examination papers.

End of year exams take place in June and will be based around a GCSE examination paper.

Reporting in year 10

Reporting to parents and pupils takes place every half term.

Pupils will receive copies of tracking immediately after every half term holiday.

Tracking reports will not give + / - / = but will provide a forecast grade for the end of year 11.

Intervention in year 10

If your child is forecast to be below target they will receive:

- Ongoing monitoring, support and feedback
- Written intervention strategies provided three times per year (Christmas, Easter, July)
- Parental partnership meeting

The parental partnership meeting

If your child is below target after the Christmas assessment you will be asked to attend a partnership meeting with the relevant subject teachers

1. Parent, pupil and teacher discuss situation
2. Intervention strategies and resources shared
3. Pupil (with support and accountability) completes intervention tasks
4. Tracking updates to follow
5. Parents evening prior to Easter
