There were lots of circles and numbers and the day culminated in the Pi competition where students tried to remember as many digits of Pi as they could, the feats of recall were amazing and it was clear that our talented students had worked really hard to memorise as much of the number as possible.

I am told that the Guinness World Record for the recall of Pi was achieved by Rajveer Meena (India) at the VIT University, Vellore, India, on 21 March 2015 and he was able to recall 70,000 digits of Pi which took him 10 hours, who knows it might be that one day in the future one of our students eventually breaks that long standing world record!

There have also been higher unofficial world records in the competitive discipline of Pi recall but the 2015 attempt is the only one recognised by Guinness World Records.

Many thanks to the representatives of Colleges and Local Businesses who attended the school on Wednesday for our annual Key Stage 4 Careers Fair. Both Year 10 and Year 11 got the opportunity to visit as many stalls as possible to learn about exciting and aspirational careers after school.
