Dear Parents/Carers

We have had a variety of assemblies this week because we have been celebrating Interfaith week and the students have had the opportunity to hear from Faith Leaders from the Jewish Faith, Muslim Faith, Buddhist Faith and Christianity, all the sessions were very informative and engaging. As usual school staff were extremely proud to be told that our students were superbly behaved during the sessions and listened attentively. Thank you to the RE department and Mr Johnson for organising the week of activities, it is wonderful that the school can do our part to increase understanding and dialogue between different Faiths through supporting the ideals of diversity and inclusion.

Astroturf Update

I am pleased to announce that the full size floodlit Astro-turf construction project has now been completed and, subject to final checks by the FA, the pitch will be ready for school and community use very soon. It has been a privilege working with the Premier League, FA and Football Foundation to secure this wonderful facility for the school that involved close to a million pounds of investment.

I would also like to thank the construction company S&C Slatter who carried out the building work as they have done a superb job with the minimum of disruption even though the school continued to be open each day of the project. The representatives from all the companies on site reported in the handover meeting that the pupils have been helpful, polite and respectful to their staff during the build, they remarked that they are amazed at our students because they don't witness such good behaviour at all the schools they work at.

In due course we will have an official opening ceremony for the pitch but we will be able to make use of the pitch before that date for PE lessons and after school activities, it is vitally important therefore that I share with you the details of the permitted footwear for students using the pitch which is attached to this letter and is available on the school's website.

When students are timetabled for PE lessons on the Astroturf in the future they must have one of these accepted forms of footwear or they will not be allowed to enter the pitch area.

Football boots with moulded studs, Football boots with screw in plastic studs less than 1.5cm, Football Boots with metal studs less than 1.5cm, Football boots with blades, Astroturf Boots.

Students cannot wear Flat Soled Trainers or Shoes to enter the pitch, this includes running/exercise/PE trainers and school shoes.

Please note: We have no control over the approved list of footwear as it is a condition of both the funding grant we have received and the ongoing insurance conditions for the pitch.

Year 11 Revision

Well done to the Year 11s who are staying behind after school for revision activities such as English Revision Hub. Students should now have received back their Mock Exam results in the majority of their subjects and these results will be posted home to parents/carers in the coming days, the mock exams are a really useful way of identifying areas that students need to concentrate on in their studies. It is of course absolutely vital that all Year 11 students are now completing additional revision outside of school including at weekends if they are going to reach their individual potential in their GCSEs. As the exams start in May, the GCSEs will be here in 3 months' time and it is crucial each Year 11 student puts the effort in now so that they are not left disappointed or wondering "what if" on results day in the Summer.

Well done to all the Year 11 students who I speak to who tell me that they are revising every day outside of school as they are building an excellent foundation for the future. Thank you also to parents/carers for encouraging and supporting your sons/daughters to do as much meaningful revision outside of school away from distracting devices and smartphones. The effort the students put in now will pay dividends in the future.
