**Students are off in relatively small numbers (i.e. less than a full class in any year group)**

Maths English Science RE set 2 tasks per week on SMHW  
One task per week should be a video explanation or lesson, any source.  
Tue/Wed Maths + English Thur/Fri Science + RE  
Other subjects one task per week on SMHW on Monday  
Option subjects at KS4 to set tasks weekly for pupils  
Assessment will be carried out on return to school by class teacher viewing the work.  
Daily contact with teachers is by PAL form time on Microsoft Teams  
Vulnerable/SEN students also have weekly contact via rm41

**Students are off in large numbers (whole year group or class told to self-isolate for up to 14 days)**

**Or Tier 2 response were rota is in place.**

Majority of tasks written assignments on SMHW  
One lesson per week should include a video explanation any source.  
One lesson/tutorial per fortnight should be via Microsoft teams. (schedule as timetable)  
Assessment will be carried out on return to school by class teacher viewing the work.  
Form time on Microsoft Teams by form teacher provides daily contact  
Vulnerable/SEN students also have weekly contact via rm41

**Lockdown significant numbers of students are absent**

One lesson/tutorial per fortnight should be via Microsoft teams. (schedule as timetable)
